## **REMINDER ABOUT THE LIGHT SYSTEM AT THE TRACK**

The towers light system has been working at the track for some time.

This is where smaller bike and bigger bikes are separated on a 20 Min on 20 Min off cycle.

On the tower, flip down signs will indicate when you are to observe the light program. The signs say "OBEY LIGHTS" when the system is in use.

When the system is not in use the signs say "MIXED GROUPS"

It is the responsibility of the rider or parent to look up at the tower as you enter the circuit. If you don't obey the lights when the signs are out YOU WILL LOSE YOUR MEMBERSHIP no excuses.

The obey lights sign is not just for heavily populated weekends and public holidays. ANY member at any time can flip down the signs if he or she wants separated riding. This will also be more prevalent during daylight saving days when lots of riders get a chance to use the track in the evening during the week.

The sign can be put back up to mixed groups if only one group of bikes remains present. REMEMBER it's up to you the member to change the signs.

BE WARNED if the sign is on "obey lights" and you are out in the wrong session YOU WILL HAVE YOUR MEMBERSHIP REVOKED.

Note to parents please explain the light system to your youngsters.
