Eligibility: Entries will be accepted forthwith from holders of current BMMXC Members & General public

Closing Date: Entries will be excepted on the day of the event. Entry Fee: \$25.00 per machine 1st class, 2nd class \$10.

Entries must be on the correct entry form and correct amount of cash or Eftpos

No entry fee or an incorrectly filled out form may result in the entry not being accepted

and being returned.

Camping: Will be permitted at the track.

Canteen: Full Catering will be available at the track.

Minimum Entries: 6 Junior / 8 Senior Solo entries to constitute a class. Grades may be combined with a higher or lower

grade if insufficient entries are received to constitute a class. The Club reserves the right to cancel a

class at its discretion.

Prizes: Senior and Junior classes will receive trophies or medallions for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd for each class. There

will be an overall Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for the whole series. You must have completed at least 3 rounds to qualify. There will also be an overall Junior Championship and Senior Championship

Trophies at the end of the year.

Corner Marshals: All riders and/or entrants are responsible for providing a representative over eighteen (18) years of age

to carry out Corner duties on their behalf. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN

RIDER BEING EXCLUDED FROM RIDING AT THIS MEETING.

Scrutineering: Riders/representatives must fill out a SELF SCRUNTINEERING FORMS

Riders Briefing: After sign-in

Racing: Will commence immediately after practice.

Grid Position: By peg selection.

Pit Boards: In designated area only as approved by the Stewards. One nominated person per rider

must register with the secretary of the meeting and sign indemnity form. The nominated person must be 18 years or over. **There will be no pit boarding during junior races.**

No Alcohol: No alcohol is permitted in the Pit or track confines.

Animals: No person may bring any animal into any area of land within the boundaries of which and event is

being conducted, unless the person has a disability and uses animals to alleviate the disability.

GENERAL:

- 1.All machines must comply with 95db rideby at 30m, as required by the Environment Protection Authority. Machines over 95db will be black flagged immediately upon detection and must be presented to the Steward of the meeting for inspection. Subject to the Steward approval of noise reduction measures the machine may be cleared to recommence racing. A second infringement will result in immediate black flagging and exclusion from the meeting. Be aware that noise testing meter will be used at this race meeting by the Stewards.
- 2. UNREGISTERED VEHICLES: Unregistered vehicles not entered in competition may not be used at a permitted event unless authorised by the Clerk of Course and under official supervision.
- 3. NUMBERS AND NUMBERPLATES: All bikes must have clear numbers. No number, no points
- 4. CHANGE OF MOTORCYCLE: A change of motorcycle may be permitted up to 15 minutes before the state of a race provided that notice is in writing and handed to the Secretary of the meeting and approval obtained by the Stewards.
- 5. BACK NUMBERS: All competitors including Seniors must wear a corresponding and legible back number at all times when practicing and competing. No back number, No points.
- 6. POINT SCORING: As per GCR's.
- 7. RIDING OF MOTORCYCLES IN THE CARPARK: Riding of a motorcycle in the pits or Car park is not permitted. Infringing riders will be bought before the Stewards of the meeting. Any offender may be fined \$20-00 which must be paid before further participation of the meeting is permitted. Note: Pit bikes are not permitted at this venue.
- 8."NO HASSLE POLICY": Any rider, entrant or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings whatsoever with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his/her own conduct and that of any person with whom he/she is associated who abuses threatens in any manner, either verbally or physically, any official. Penalties which may be imposed by the Stewards for any breach include reprimand or warning, Minimum of \$50-00 fine or exclusion from the meeting.
- 9. ABANDONMENT: In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned less \$5-00 per entry to cover administration costs. Once the competition has commenced only the Stewards of the meeting have the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the Stewards will rule on the results according to the circumstances.
- 10. BICYCLES: Bicycles are not permitted in the pits or on the racing circuit.
- 11. MOTORCYCLES: Are to be kept in the pit area at all times when not being used for competition. unless permission to remove the motorcycle has been granted by the Stewards of the meeting. Any motorcycle removed from the pit area without permission of the Stewards will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.
- 12.RESERVATIONS: The Stewards of the meeting reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.
 13.UNAUTHORISED persons are prohibited from entering the track infield area. Such unauthorised persons will be removed from prohibited areas.

14. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS/ENTRANTS/PARENTS/GUARDIANS: THIS IS NOT AN MV PERMITTED EVENT

It is a condition upon acceptance this entry that it is fully understood by the rider/entrant/parent/guardian to arrange personal injury, ambulance transportation insurance cover in case you should require same during this competition.
